Mode	Explanation	Course code ends in ...
Blended courses	These are courses which have an integral face-to-face element with the facilitator, plus online activities to be carried out before and after the two hour facilitated face-to-face session.	B
Web-based courses	These are online courses , although like all Vital courses they involve participants in planning and implementing activities in their work settings.	W
Online with optional face-to-face introductory session	These are identical to the corresponding web-based courses, except that they have a 2 hour face-to-face session at the beginning of the course. The introductory face-to-face session always involves a 'hands-on' component to help participants engage with web-based elements of the course. In addition it allows participants to meet the facilitator and start to get to know the other members of their course cohort.	O
